

**Terms of Reference (ToRs)**  
**of the**  
**Local Consultative Working groups (LCG WG)**  
**on Power & Energy**

**Background**

The Local consultative group (LCG) is a formal mechanism for dialogue to ensure the effectiveness of development endeavors. It comprises of development partners including the multilateral and bilateral agencies, international financial institutions, the UN agencies and the Government.

Local Consultative Groups (LCG) is to coordinate its developmental and sectoral goals, policies, and strategies with Development Partners (DPs) for enhancing the effectiveness of development cooperation.

The LCG WG (Power & Energy) will play a remarkable role to ensuring energy security for the country through supply of sustainable energy services for all at affordable prices and exploit mineral resources in an environmentally sustainable manner through implementation of 8th Five Year Plan, SDG, Vision 2041.

To create effective coordination between GOB and Development Partners Local Consultative Group (LCG) working group were formed by Economic Relation Division. Earlier 18 LCG Working Group was formed covering different sectors. To strengthen the functions and effectiveness the existing LCG Working Groups have been reconstructed. Approved working groups have been restructured on the basis of LCG Review Report-2019, 8th Five Year Plan, views of concerned Ministries/ Departments and Development Partners. The newly structured 14 LCG WGs have been endorsed at the LCG GOB-DP Plenary meeting held on 21 November 2021. The LCG-Working Group (Power & Energy) will be chaired by the Senior Secretary of the Energy & Mineral Resources Division and co-chaired by the ADB (up to the specified time) on behalf of the Development Partners.

**Objective**

The over-arching goal of the LCG WG (Power & Energy) is to move towards better information sharing and coordination between and among the Government of Bangladesh (GoB) and development partners (DPs) on all aspects related to power & energy and specifically to improving power sector efficiency, reducing transmission and distribution losses and alternative sources of energy



- ✓ Identify shared Power & Energy related concerns, and maintaining a constructive dialogue with the GoB and DPs;
- ✓ Disseminate good practices as well as share lessons learnt

The LCG WG (Power & Energy) will regularly report on its activities to the LCG Plenary. The LCG WG (Power & Energy) will closely collaborate with the LCG WG on Aid Effectiveness in all matters related to the implementation of the Joint Cooperation Strategy and reform of the LCG.
